### What is the Supportive and Chronic Illness Program?

Transcend Healthcare's Chronic Illness Program is designed to help patients with chronic and serious medical conditions better manage their



conditions and improve their health. Our team (which consists of physicians, nurse practitioners, nurses, and social workers) work closely with you and your family to personalize your care based on your treatment goals. We communicate your goals to your health care team (including your primary care physician, your consulting physicians, your home health and caregiver services, and facilities (if you are living in a facility)).

### Who makes up your Supportive Care Team?



Your team of compassionate professionals consists of individuals who are extensively trained in palliative and

supportive care. They have been trained to help treat difficult to treat conditions, and carry specialized certifications in palliative care. The team consists of physicians, nurse practitioners, nurses and social workers who help monitor you and keep the rest of your treatment team informed about how you are doing and how you are responding to treatment.

### What kind of Support is Provided?

Transcend supports you and your family and caregivers by educating and providing information regarding your health. We also review available treatment options and help you navigate the complex healthcare landscape we live in today.

### What Services are Included?

Transcend Healthcare provides services wherever you live. This includes your home, nursing home, assisted living facility, independent living



facility, or group home. Your care starts with a visit from one of our Nurse Practitioners or Physicians who will evaluate your clinical, physical and emotional needs. They will discuss your condition with you, review options and discuss treatment goals. Once this has been established, the care plan will be shared with our nursing staff and social workers to help address your needs. The care plan will also be shared with your Primary Care Physician (PCP), as well as other consultants, and services you may be receiving.
